The following pages are a transcription of the National Archives' finding aid for World War II Combat Interviews in the version published in 2016. Thanks very much to Mike Croissant for sending me the images of the 2016 edition and alerting me to the change.

The last time I was at National Archives II at College Park, MD, this finding aid was found in the books of finding aids, located in the glass-walled Research Consultation area within the second-floor textual record reading room.

I had transcribed the original (to me) finding aid in 2004, but about 2007 all of the RG 407 Entry 427 and 427-A records were re-boxed, so that the old boxes numbers were no longer valid. So, a second edition of the finding aid required transcription. In 2016, the combat interviews were re-boxed so that the new inventory in this document (the third edition) was needed. The document below contains the new June 2016 box numbers.

When filling out pull slips for these records, the RG No. is "407". The Stack Area / Row / Compartment / Shelf are "270/62/8/4". In the Record Identification, include "Entry 427-A" and the box number that you want. Pulls of consecutive box numbers can be made on a single pull slip.

If you do research in these records, PLEASE strictly adhere to the National Archives' research guidelines and keep these records in the order that you find them.

- Never have two boxes off the cart or open at one time.
- Never have two files out of a box at one time.
- Never have two documents out of a file at one time.

There are already too many people who thought that the rules applied to everyone but themselves, and the result is that many records have been misplaced because these careless people put documents "back" into the wrong folder or the wrong box, so that later researchers cannot find things.

In as detailed a document as this one is, it is almost certain that I have made transcription errors. If you think you have found an error, please contact me and let me know what and where it is. I do have images of the original and can check those.

I have retained page breaks and a general version of the formatting, but I have not tried to duplicate the exact formatting of every entry. I have added footnotes.

INTRODUCTION

The following pages contain an index to Combat Interviews made in the European Theater of Operations during 1944 and 1945. These records form part of a series of records identified as "Narrative Reports and Supporting Documents Relating to Operations and Activities of the Army During World War II and the Postwar Period ('Operations Reports File'), 1940-48." The series

is from the Records of the Adjutant General's Office, 1917- (Record Group 407) and they were declassified under Declassification Review Project 735017.

The Combat Interviews pertain primarily to American combat activities on the Continent of Europe between June 1944 and May 1945. Among the combat actions included are those relating to the Normandy Landing and Breakthrough; Operations Cobra, Neptune, and Market; the Battles of Aachen, the Bulge, and the Hurtgen Forest; the Siege of Bastogne; the Rhine and Moselle River Crossings; the Remagen Bridgehead; the Siegfried Line; the Brest, Ardennes, Roer to the Rhine, and the Rhine-Ruhr-Elbe Operations; and the Colmar and Ruhr Pockets. Also included are interviews relating to the first contacts between the Russian and American forces and the entry of American forces into concentration camps.

Besides the Combat Interviews, there are also aerial maps, aerial photographs, diagrams, field orders, graphs, instructions, maps, narratives, overlays, overlays, operation reports, photographs, periodic reports, sketches, and statistical charts.
