

I wish to assure you that, should any additional evidence come to our attention indicating that his remains are in our possession, you will be informed immediately.

Realizing the extent of your grief and anxiety, it is not easy to express condelence to you who gave your loved one under circumstances so difficult that there is no grave at which to pay homage. May the knowledge of your son's honorable service to his country be a source of sustaining comfort to you.

1. It is recommended that the board take action on the following case:

NAME: REUSCH, Hubert L. T/4 35 283 868

ORGANIZATION: Co. "A" 17 Tank Bn.

PLACE OF DEATH: SILLEGRY, FRANCE

DATE OF DEATH: 18 Sept 1944

SYNOPSIS OF CASE: The above was a crew member of a tank which was destroyed by the enemy at SILLEGRY, FRANCE, 18 september 1944. According to the subject casualtys commanding officer the tank received a direct hit and burst into flames. Witnesses testified at the time, that it would have been impossible for T/4 Reusch to have evacuated the burning vehicle. The tank was examined at a later date but no trace of the subject deceased could be found due to the complete destruction of the tanks interior. In view of the above and the time that has elapsed since the missing man has neither been seen nor heard from, it can be concluded that he was killed in this tank and the remains totally consumed in the resultant fire. Reference is made to OQMG form 371 for T/4 Hubert L. REUSCH.

- 2. Every effort has been made to correlate this case with records in this headquarters pertaining to unknown deceased, interred in US Military Cometeries and reported isolated burials. The results are negative.
- 3. It is recommended that the remains, based upon the above information and research, be declared non-recoverable.





Meanwhile, we are requesting that unit to give us any new information which they may have concerning the recovery and burial of the remains of your son.

There is presently no provision whereby the Government may provide a headstone or marker to be erected as a memorial in your family plot in remembrance of your son, whose remains have not, as yet, been identified or recovered.

Legislation to provide for such memorials was submitted to the 79th-Congress, but was not enacted into law.

There is no provision whereby the War Department may pay a monetary allowance in lieu of the Government supplied headstone or marker.

I greatly regret the delay in answering your letter and wish to extend my deepest sympathy in the loss of your son. I
