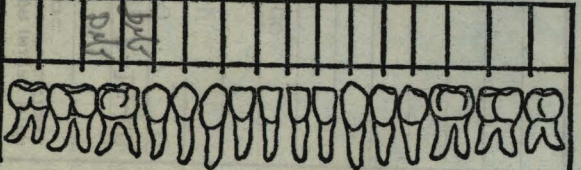

SYNOPSIS OF CASE: The above was a crew member of a tank which was destroyed by the enemy at SILLEGRY, FRANCE, 18 September 1944. According to the subject casualty's commanding officer the tank received a direct hit and burst into flames. Witnesses testified at the time, that it would have been impossible for T/4 Reusch to have evacuated the burning vehicle. The tank was examined at a later date but no trace of the subject deceased could be found due to the complete destruction of the tank's interior. In view of the above and the time that has elapsed since the missing man has neither been seen nor heard from, it can be concluded that he was killed in this tank and the remains totally consumed in the resultant fire. Reference is made to OQMG form 371 for T/4 Hubert L. REUSCH.

2. Every effort has been made to correlate this case with records in this headquarters pertaining to unknown deceased, interred in US Military Cemeteries and reported isolated burials. The results are negative.

3. It is recommended that the remains, based upon the above information and research, be declared non-recoverable.

Your letter pertaining to the remains of your son, the late Technician Fourth Grade Hubert L. Reusch, has come to my attention.

With deep regret, I must inform you that, as yet, no information additional to that previously given you pertaining to the burial of the remains of your son has been received in this office. Please rest assured, however, that immediately a report is received from the American Graves Registration Command unit operating in the area in which your son died, I shall promptly inform you. Meanwhile, we are requesting that unit to give us any new information which they may have concerning the recovery and burial of the remains of your son.

There is presently no provision whereby the Government may provide a headstone or marker to be erected as a memorial in your family plot in remembrance of your son, whose remains have not, as yet, been identified or recovered.

Legislation to provide for such memorials was submitted to the 79th Congress, but was not enacted into law.

There is no provision whereby the War Department may pay a monetary allowance in lieu of the Government supplied headstone or marker.

I greatly regret the delay in answering your letter and wish to extend my deepest sympathy in the loss of your son.

Your reply received March 6-47, no record of my son's remains. Will say their never will be, as the government said the tank burst into flames, when it received the direct hit, & at a later date, witnesses testified that it would have been impossible for Hubert to get out of tank, & bodies were in pieces, & burned beyond recognition, is the reason there is no record of their remains. I waited 8 mo. for the word he was killed the same day he was reported missing.

To make a long story short, I see in paper the Government pays all

costs of exhumation², preparation of remains, casket casketing + forwarding to a place designated by next-of-kin. If burial in a private cemetery is chosen, the Government in addition pays up to \$50⁰⁰ for burial expenses. In addition, upon request, the Gov. will provide a headstone or grave marker of a standardized kind.

In our case, there are no remains to be brought here, but we have a cemetery lot, + I have had a couple salesman here about a monument + having his name, rank, where killed + etc. on monument, also a gold star. The gold star is \$25⁰⁰ extra. What does the gov. do in this case, or would you please tell me what they are willing to do.

If Hubert were buried overseas, (he was killed near Sillgery France) I would certainly want

his body brought³ here, but in our case, there will be none of that expense, but I do want a monument of some kind, + hope the gov. can or will give a certain amt. toward one.

Thanking you for all past letters + I will be anxiously waiting for your reply, as my selection must depend on what the gov. will do. I certainly would like the monument, being I can't have his body, is the reason I am asking if they will do something toward same.

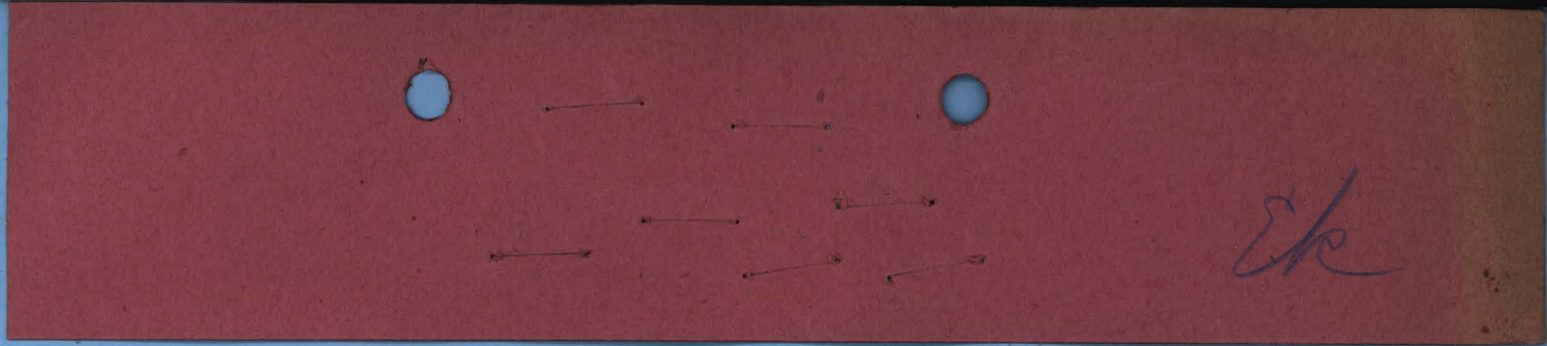

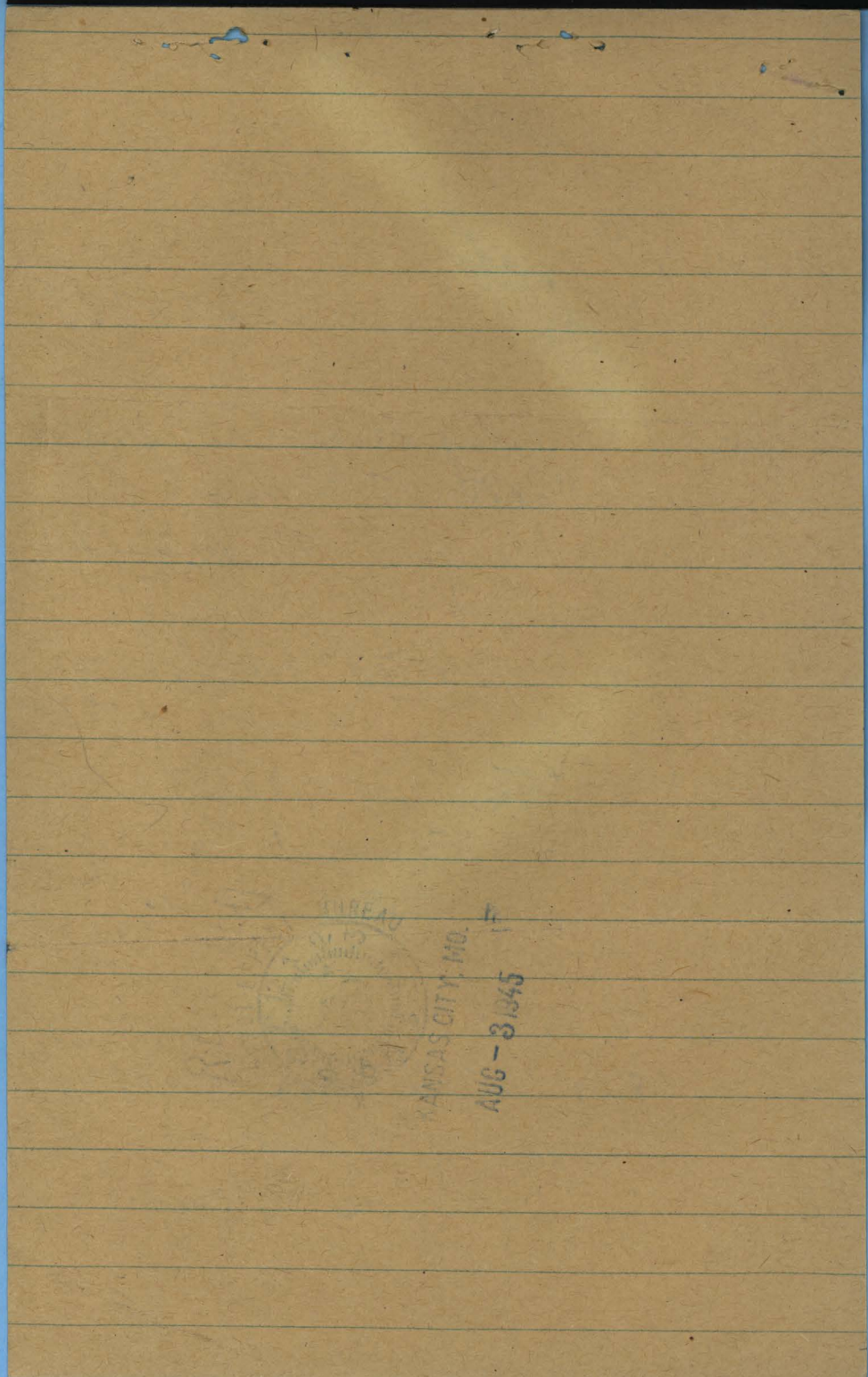
