SYNOPSIS: The casualties listed on attached roster are reported by official records as Missing in Action or Killed in Action during ground or air operations in the department of Moselle, France, from the period 5 September 1944 to 16 March 1945. Extensive area searches as well as individual investigation have to date failed to furnish information as to the ultimate disposition of their remains. Efforts to effect association with unidentified recoveries from the area, now interred in U.S. Military Cemeteries, have also proven negative. The lack of specific information regarding the death or burial, limited search in most instances to general localities, however, documents on file in this Office and Office of The Quartermaster General substantiate the fact that numerous investigations covering the entire department of Moselle have been conducted in the course of search operations for all losses, both recovered and unrecovered. The terrain of the Moselle department, for the most part, consists of farm. pasture and forested areas which has been under constant cultivation and supervision by farmers and forest guards, since the cessation of hostilities, thus the possibility of undiscovered graves is remote. It can therefore be concluded that the remains of the deceased in question were reduced by battle action to a state which precludes recovery or identification. The absence of specific information concerning their deaths, the failure of Field Investigations to provide

evidence and the lack of association with recovered unknowns would tend to substantiate these conclusions. It is recommended that the remains of the individuals listed in these Board Proceedings be considered Non-Recoverable under the provisions of paragraph 3b, Letter, Office of The Quartermaster General, file QMGMP 293, Subject: Processing Board Findings of Non-Recoverability Return of World War II Dead Program, dated 25 March 1949.

#### MARRATIVE OF INVESTIGATION

#### I. AUTHORITY:

In compliance with Investigation Directive # 243, dated 25 April 1950 an investigation was conducted in the vicinity of STILEGHY (p-9/4-64) France in an effort to recover the remains of the following listed casualties:

JOHNSON, Roger B.	PV	34 875 393
SIARKARD, Buen J.	2/4	37 010 778
MEST, Robert D.	6/684	6 345 808
WILLIAMS, Evon	5/5gt	6 393 665

#### II. FACTS AND CIRCURSTANCES:

The above listed casualties were crew members of two (2) tanks of the 17th Tank Bn. 7th Arad Div which were destroyed by enery shell fire in the area 3 or 400 yards west of SILLEMN, France on the 18 - 19 - September 1944. Statement of an eyewitness indicates that West, Slankard and Johnson were not seen to leave the vehicle. There is no additional information available concerning the circumstances under which Milliams was killed.

#### III. FINDINGS:

A visit was first made to the village of SILLBOMY where contact was made with the Mayor, Mr Mathis. He stated that all remains, both ascrican and derman, which had been recovered from the territory of this community, had been evacuated by ASAC units. (See Incl #1). He further produced area Search Cortificate and Motices of Disinterment which indicate that eleven (11) American, forty-one (41) German and five (5) unknown remains were taken from HILLEONY in April and May 1946. Copies of these records were made and are attached as part of this investigation. (See Inc #2). The mayor also stated that the area has been completely demined and that all wrenked tanks and vehicles were removed at that time. He does not know where they were taken and was never informed of the finding of any admittanal remains during this operation. He further stated that the wrockage of a tank which was not considered important enough to remove is still lying in a field which approximates the area indicated in this case. A visit was made to this wreckage where it was found to consist of only a few pieces of twisted steel and a length of cable. There are no markings visible and it is inpossible to determine anything except that it is of American manufacture.

#### NARRATIVE OF INVESTIGATION:

4 May 1950

an extensive search was then made over the entire area which is now under cultivation and small piles of debris which have been accumulated by the fermers as they have turned up in the cultivation of the land were examined. No traces of human remains were discovered and nothing to indicate that this debris was once part of an american tank or tanks could be found. All woods in the area were visited and foxholes and slit trenches found there were examined with negative results.

### IV. CONGLUSION:

The area indicated in this case has been thouroughly investigated. pemining and salvage operations failed to reveal any trace of additional remains. The village of SILLEGHY was almost completely destroyed and consequently extension rebuilding and contractions work has been done in the area without additional remains being discovered. The land has been under cultivation for a period of several years and drainage ditches and roads have been constructed in the area where this action took place. No additional remains have been discovered and no isolated graves reported.

#### RECOISIBLE DATION:

That records be checked in an effort to determine the disposition of the remains listed in an unknown status on copy of Area Search Certificate No 1. undated and Notice of Disinterment dated 28 May 1946 (No 4.) supposedly taken to U.S. Military Cemetery of GEREMSHEIM.

That if the results of this search are negative, this case be consi-





Your letter concerning your husband, the late Staff Sergeant Robert D. West, has been received in this office.

It is with deep regret that you are advised that, up to the present time, information pertaining to the burial of the remains of your husband has not been received in this office. Upon receipt of information you will be advised.

The War Department anticipates that, in the near future, authority will be granted to return, at Government expense, the remains of those who died overseas to a final resting place as selected by the next of kin.

When the necessary legislation authorizing this Repatriation Program receives Congressional approval and other required arrangements have been made, a poll letter, with a return form and an information pamphlet attached, will be sent to the next of kin of each deceased serviceman whose remains lie overseas and for whom verified burial information has been received.

Since the problem itself, and the planning and arrangements therefor, are world-wide in scope, the date when the poll letter can be mailed and the date when the answers will be received and can be acted upon is necessarily uncertain. It should be realized, however, that the next of kin will be notified without action on their part as soon as the necessary preliminaries have been completed. You may rest assured that this office fully appreciates your desires in this matter and till to everything in its power to fulfill them at the earliest possible date.




