The casualties listed on attached roster are re-SYNOPSIS: ported by official records as Missing in Action or Killed in Action during ground or air operations in the department of Moselle, France, from the period 5 September 1944 to 16 March 1945. Extensive area searches as well as individual investigation have to date failed to furnish information as to the ultimate disposition of their remains. Efforts to effect association with unidentified recoveries from the area, now interred in U.S. Military Cemeteries, have also proven negative. The lack of specific information regarding the death or burial, limited search in most instances to general localities, however, documents on file in this Office and Office of The Quartermaster General substantiate the fact that numerous investigations covering the entire department of Moselle have been conducted in the course of search operations for all losses, both recovered and unrecovered. terrain of the Moselle department, for the most part, consists of farm, pasture and forested areas which has been under constant cultivation and supervision by farmers and forest guards, since the cessation of hostilities, thus the possibility of undiscovered graves is remote. It can therefore be concluded that the remains of the deceased in question were reduced by battle action to a state which precludes recovery or identification. The absence of specific information concerning their deaths, the failure of Field Investigations to provide

evidence and the lack of association with recovered unknowns would tend to substantiate these conclusions. Some elements of the Battalion had crossed the Moselle River, but determined enemy forces counter-attached in such large numbers with artillery, mortar and tank fire until a withdrawal ofbridgehead and troop in Dornot, France was made. The 23rd Armored Infantry suffered many casualties from these operations.

It is with profound regret that I confirm the recent telegram informing you of the death of your son, Private Lloyd Foy, 34,253,686, Infantry, who was previously reported missing in action since 10 September 1944 in France.

An official message has now been received which states that he was killed in action on the date he was previously reported missing in action. Provisions have been made for the unit commander or chaplain to send a letter containing further information to the emergency addresses or next of kin of each person who dies overseas in the service of our country. It is not known just when the letter can be expected, but it is hoped that it will not be long delayed.

I realize the anxiety you have suffered since he was first reported missing in action and deeply regret the sorrow this later report brings you. May the knowledge that he made the supreme sacrifice for his home and country be a source of sustaining comfort.

My sympathy is with you in this time of great sorrow.

It is with the greatest personal sorrow that I write to express our sense of loss in the death of your son and our comrade, Private Lloyd Foy, 34 253 686.

He was killed in action on the 10th of September 1944, while we were engaged in a particularly hazardous undertaking at Dornot, France. During the course of the engagement fierce enemy resistance was encountered and the lives of many of our soldiers endangered. Private Foy, by his heroic actions on that occasion contributed materially to the success of our mission and in so doing lost his life.

Those of us who knew your son always respected him and admired him for his courage and devotion to duty. Your sorrow and ours on his loss is something beyond writing or speech. We can say only this: we are proud to have known him and we will always remember him with affection. He died for his country.

You will, I am sure, be above to find some consolation in the knowledge that the rites of his religion were extended him by our Chaplain before he entered battle.


