1. Rigid precautions will be instituted at once to safeguard arms and ammunition in the hands of troops.
2. Arms.
 - a. Removable vehicular and crew operated weapons, when not in use will be kept locked in arms rooms provided at motor parks.
 - b. Vehicular weapons on tanks which are capable of being locked inside the tanks will be so secured.
 - c. Suitable guards will be posted to insure safety of weapons.
 - d. Individual weapons will be issued by SERIAL NUMBER to individual soldiers. They will be kept under lock and key when not in use.
 - e. When arms racks are not available (no additional can be drawn) one of the NCO rooms in barracks or other suitable building will be prepared as an armory and individual weapons stored therein when not in use.
 - f. All weapons; individual, crew, and vehicular will be checked in and out by serial number daily whether for training with the weapons or for cleaning when the weapons are not used for training.
 - g. Any shortage will be reported to this headquarters immediately upon discovery.
3. Ammunition.
 - a. Small arm ammunition will be drawn in only sufficient quantities to meet the demand for one week's firing.
 - b. Only that amount estimated for the day or other period of continuous firing will be taken to the range or other training areas.
 - c. Other types of ammunition or grenades will be drawn in the late afternoon for the next day's use only and will be stored outside the building.
4. a. Before any unit leaves the target range or any training area where ball ammunition has been fired, the unit will be caused to "fall in" and be inspected by an officer to insure that no ball ammunition remains in the hands of the enlisted men.
 - b. Frequent searches without prior warning will be made of barracks including trunks, lockers, and personnel to insure compliance with the above directive.

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
