This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

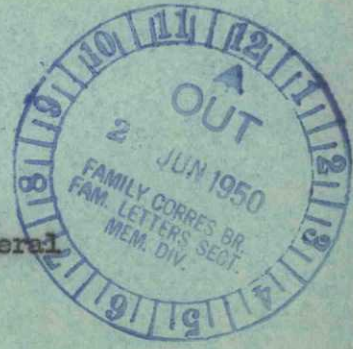
After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

Your letter to the Adjutant General concerning your son, the late First Lieutenant Stephen T. Lowry, has been referred to this office.

I regret that I must inform you that information concerning the burial of the remains of your son has not yet been received in this office. However, our Graves Registration forces in the field are making a complete and thorough search of all areas over which our men fought. All available information such as enemy reports of death and burial, either captured or transmitted through the International Red Cross, results of interrogation of returned prisoners of War, statements made by natives of the localities being searched, and reports submitted by Commanding Officers and fellow soldiers who were in the vicinity at the time of the fatality, are being used to implement their efforts. It is contemplated that all remains so recovered will be interred in established American Military Cemeteries pending the initiation of the Program of Repatriation. I sincerely hope that this intensive search will result in the discovery and the identification of your son's remains. Please be assured that when information is received that this is accomplished and his remains have been properly interred, you will be informed without delay.

Please accept my sincere sympathy in the loss of your son.

He was posthumously awarded the Silver Star for gallantry in action from 8 to 10 Sept. 44 near Dornot, France. According to the "After Action Report", Co. "K", 11th Inf. crossed the Moselle river in the vicinity of Dornot, France on 8 Sept. 44 and on 9 Sept. 44, Co. "K" was still holding a small bridgehead on the east bank of the Moselle against intense enemy fire and counter-attack. X-43 was recovered near Jouy aux Arches, France, which is across the Moselle and slightly north of Dornot, France.</p> <p>Tooth chart for X-43 compares more favorably with dental records of Lt. Lowry than with any other unresolved casualty of Lieutenants listed in the Moselle Dept., France.</p> <p>CIL estimates the height of X-43 to be 6'0" and the weight at about 180 lbs. Lt. Lowry was 5'11" tall and weighed 146 lbs.</p> <p>Type of clothing found with X-43 is in agreement with Lt. Lowry's branch of service and two First Lieutenant bars found with X-43 is in agreement with 1/Lt. Lowry's rank.</p> <p>A key for a Master padlock #P329 was found with X-43. Efforts to associate this key with personal effects of Lt. Lowry have met with negative results; however, this does not preclude identification.</p>

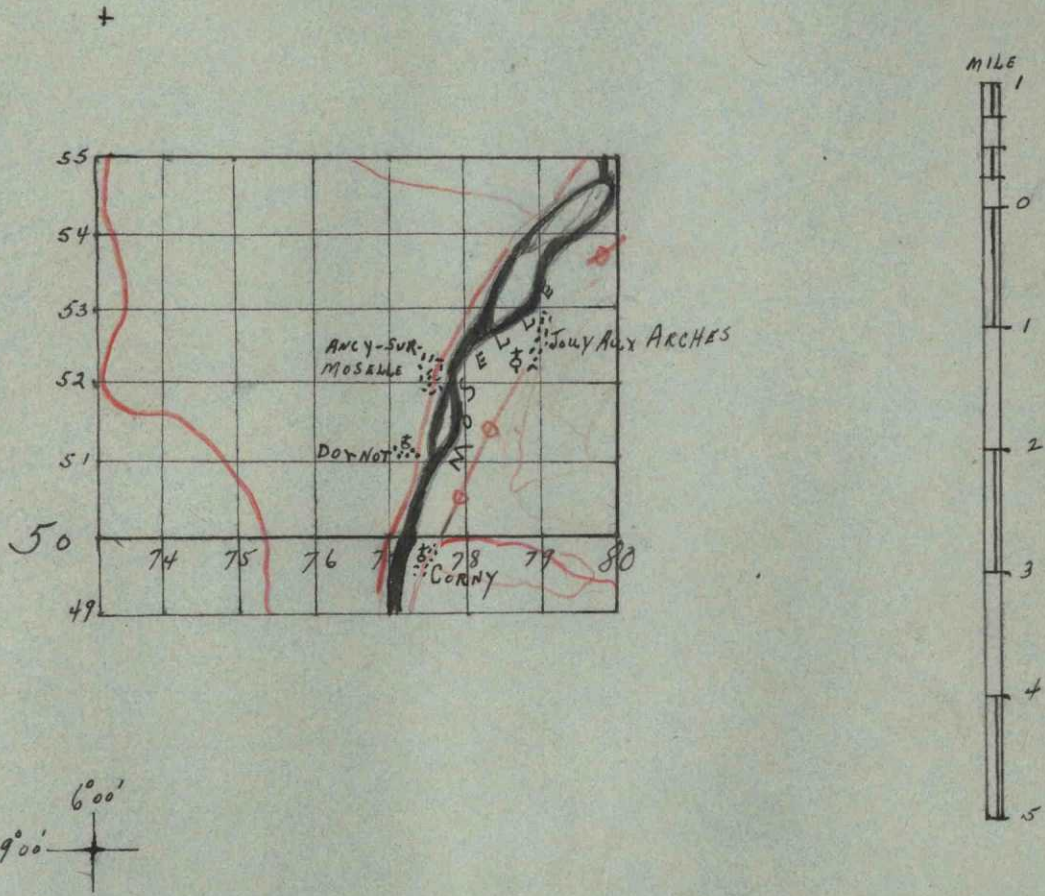

A search of records in this Office reveals three other Unknown remains (X-22, X-60 USMC Limey, France and X-6012 St. Avold) recovered from the same vicinity as X-43. All three of these Unknowns can be eliminated as a possibility of being Lt. Lowry by negative comparison of tooth charts and/or height estimate and laundry markings.

Two other remains recovered at the same time and in the immediate vicinity of X-43 were identified as Pvt. Carl R. Apple, 35295432 and Pfc. Gilbert E. Grunke, 16007984, both members of the (11th Inf. Regt.) same organization of which Lt. Lowry was a member.

The previous identity of X-43 as 1/Lt. Nathan F. Drake, O-382849 based on similarity in height, weight, trousers size, type of wound and place of death was erroneous. Lt. Drake's remains were subsequently recovered near Fort St. Elaise, Fey, Moselle, France, identified by ID tag, tooth chart, 1/Lt. bar and insignia and are now permanently interred in Plot A, Row 28, Grave 39, USMC St. Avold, France.

Dear Mr. Lowry:

I have the honor to inform you that, by direction of the President, the Silver Star has been posthumously awarded to your son, First Lieutenant Stephen T. Lowry, Infantry. The citation is as follows:

SILVER STAR

"For gallantry in action from 8 to 10 September 1944 near *****^{DARNOT, FRANCE} *****. During an intense enemy barrage of artillery mortar, automatic and small arms fire, the enemy attempted a fanatical counterattack upon our forces as they attempted to enlarge a small bridgehead across the *****^{MOSELLE RIVER} *****. Lieutenant Lowry, a company commander, personally evacuated four wounded men from the front lines when they were injured by enemy artillery fire. After evacuating the casualties, he administered necessary first aid to them and then he secured and delivered rations to the men in their foxholes to obviate necessity of exposure by them to the constant artillery fire. Lieutenant Lowry obtained a heavy automatic weapon and moved to the front of his company to bolster his lines, and in so doing, drew enemy fire and fatally wounded. His outstanding devotion to duty and self-sacrifice reflect much credit on himself and our Armed Forces."

The decoration will be forwarded to the Commanding General, Fifth Service Command, Fort Hayes, Columbus, Ohio, who will select an officer to make the presentation. The officer selected will communicate with you concerning your wishes in the matter.

May I again express my deepest sympathy to you in your bereavement.

11TH INFANTRY REGIMENT

After Action Report

08 Sept 44: 2d Bn assisted by Co "C", 7th Engr and supported by 5th Inf Div Arty (- 50 & 241 FA Bns) made assault crossing of MOSELLE RIVER in the vicinity of DORNOT (775512) beginning 1045B after 5 hours delay due to conflicting orders existing between elements of the 7th Armd Div and 5th Inf Div as to order of the crossing. Crossing was continued by assault boats throughout the day and hours of darkness in face of heavy enemy artillery, mortar and machine gun fire. Companies "E", "F", "G" and "K", and majority of "H" were crossed when heavy enemy counterattack at dusk compressed bridgehead and stopped crossing of additional elements of 3d Bn. 1st and 3d Bns continued to hold position on the W bank of the MOSELLE RIVER.

09 Sept 44 2d Bn and Company "K", continued to hold the bridgehead against intense enemy fire and counterattacks. Enemy fire prevented further crossings. Evacuation and resupply of bridgehead forces conducted on night of 9-10 September 44.

10 Sept 44 2d Bn and Co "K" continued to hold small bridgehead on E bank of the MOSELLE RIVER approximately 300 by 200 yards, despite high casualties during daylight. Orders received to evacuate bridgehead. Evacuation begun at 2115 hours and completed 2330 hours. 2d Bn moved into Div reserve in GORZE. 3d Bn (less Co's "I" and "K" and plus Co's "B" and "C", plus Co "I") moved into position to hold high ground west of DORNOT and protect left flank on the west bank.

11 Sept 44 3d Bn (minus "I" and "K", plus "B" and "C" Co's) completed crossing all elements to east bank of the MOSELLE RIVER and secured positions on north flank of Division bridgehead against strong enemy resistance. 3d Bn attached to 10th Inf upon completion of crossing. 2d Bn in Division reserve, reorganizing. 1st Bn (minus "B" and "C" and plus Co "I") in position on high ground west of DORNOT protecting left flank.

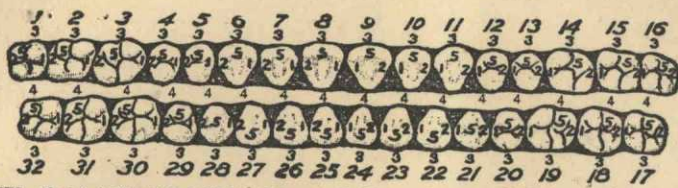

CASE HISTORY

UNKNOWN NO X-43

U.S. Military Cemetery Hamm, Luxembourg

Lt. Stephen T. Lowry was killed in Dornot, France on 9 Sept. 1944, according to records on file at this headquarters.

X-43 Hamm was recovered from Jouy aux Arches, France, and because he was picked up with identified member of 11th Inf. Regt. who was killed on 9 Sept., it was assumed that date of death was also probably 9 Sept. According to Gazetteer of France, the coordinates for Jouy aux Arches and Dornot are both the same (Sheet 9-U-75).

When remains of X-43 were originally found in February 1945, remark was made on report of burial that X-43 had ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ not been circumcised, however, initial remarks on subject report of burial indicate that remains and clothing were in such a state that person features were not recognisable and clothing fell apart when touched. Due to the fact that this is the only contradictory factor in the case, it can be eliminated on basis of above.

In order to further substantiate the identity of X-43 as Lt. Lowry, a search was made of all open cards in files of Isolated Burials branch, this headquarters, ~~for~~ for cases listed in Moselle Department, France. A cable was sent to OCMG for all dental information on all Lieutenants listed as killed in this department, and, when received, were all negative, with the exception of Lt. Lowry.
