1. The Army Effects Bureau has received one Combat Infantry badge and one ribbon recovered as the personal effects found in group burial of Unknown decedents X-214, X-215, and X-216, interred in Castelfiorentino, Italy. Inclosed are pertinent overseas inventory and original Graves Registration label covering transmittal of the property.

2. Bureau inspection of the items failed to reveal any information which would be of assistance in establishing the identity of the Unknown decedents. The property has been held at this Bureau as of 18 September 1945, pending report of identification from your office.

3. It is requested that the burial reports available at your office be checked and this Bureau informed whether Unknown decedents have been identified. In the event sufficient information is not available at your office to establish the identity of the Unknown decedents, information as to the present status of this case will be appreciated.

1. The remains of Unknown Americans X-214, X-215 and X-216 were recovered from a fox-hole at Grid Coords: Q 91.6-96.7, Map of Italy 1/200,000 and interred in U.S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino, Italy, plot 2-G, row 94, graves 4573, 4574 and 4575 respectively.

2. In the fox-hole were found parts of three (3) OD shirts, one with an 85th Division patch; one with a combat Infantry badge and campaign ribbon with one (1) star, a helmet liner marked "6424", and a canteen cup marked "R.H."; but individual ownership could not be determined.

3. Records indicate that on the 13th and 14th September 1944, the 338th and 339th Infantry Regiments of the 85th Division were in this area. Listings indicate no unrecovered 85th Division casualties for eleven (11) days preceding and ten (10) days following this period.

4. Request the toothchart of Unknown Americans X-214, X-215 and X-216 on file War Department be checked against the toothcharts of the following 85th Division casualties.

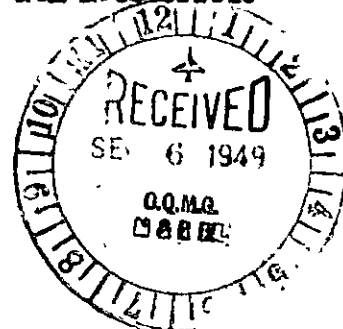

1. The remains of Unknown Americans X-258, X-259, X-260 and X-261 were disinterred from a common grave in the vicinity of Collina, Italy, Grid Coords: L 9.3-3.3, Sheet 11, Map of Italy 1/200,000 and reinterred in the U.S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino, Italy: plot 2-J, row 89, graves 4804, 4805, 4806 and 4807 respectively.

2. The bodies were in a skeleton stage and no identifying marks were found except part of an identification card which read "S Sgt W. P. Coff U.S. Army". Ownership of this card could not be determined.

3. A.G. Casualty cards, this theater, beginning with Coff through Coffy were processed to eliminate all personnel killed in action and missing in action, south of Rome. Of the three possibilities, only one (1) S Sgt Coffron, Willard J., 36 500 210, DFW is unrecovered.

4. The following physical characteristics are known:

5. Records, this headquarters, indicate that an investigation of the circumstances surrounding the disappearance of Pvt Leo L. Davis, 36 986 821, Pvt Thomas S. Fallin, 34 948 916 and Pvt Thomas B. Norman, 35 838 992, all missing in action 5 February 1945, reveals that on that particular date at 1400 hours, Company F, 133rd Infantry Regiment, 34th Division attacked from Grid Coords: 929.826 with the mission to take and to hold the town of Collina

93 York X-258 thru 261 Italy (Castelfiorentino)

Ltr: OQMG "Identification of American Deceased (Case 'Macrentino)", 7 September 4

Italy. About 10 minutes later, after an advance of approximately 150 yards on the road leading to Collina, the enemy inflicted heavy casualties on Company F. About two hours later Company F started to withdraw and by 2300 hours most of the men had returned. The above named were still missing.

7. Since the remains of Thomas B. Norman, 35 838 992, 133rd Infantry Regiment, KIA 5 February 1945 were found at Grid Coords: L 931-323, it is believed from the above information that subject deceased are, in truth, the four above listed men.

8. Request toothchart of X-258 and X-260 on file War Department be checked against the toothcharts of the above listed Unrecovered Casualties and a report of findings be submitted this headquarters as soon as practicable.
