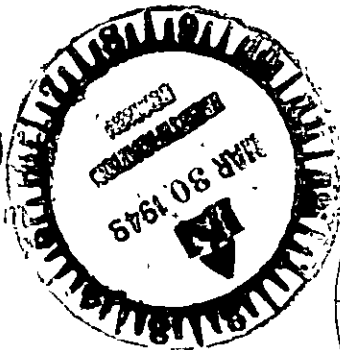

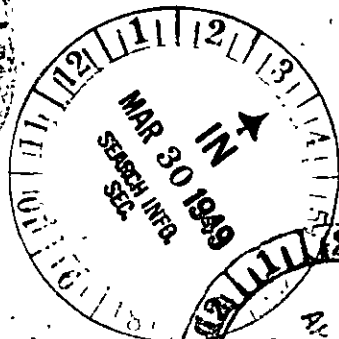

1. The remains of Unknown American X-279 were recovered from a hole about 15 feet deep in the vicinity of C. del Giardino, Grid Coords: 01.1-02.4, Map of Italy 1/100,000, Sheet 96, and interred in U.S. Military Cemetery, Castelfiorentino, Italy, in plot 2-J, row 93, grave 4857, on 28 August 1946.

2. Information available this headquarters indicates that X-279 was taken Prisoner of War and was shot by the Germans after interrogation. Remains were thrown in the deep hole by the Italians because body had begun to putrify. Nothing was found to assist in establishing the soldier's identity. It is understood that X-279 was held prisoner in a barbed wire enclosure prior to being shot. Date indicated as December 1944.

1. Submitted herewith is report of investigation concerning the recovery of remains referred to as Unknown X-279.

2. Remains were recovered by T/5 Tadashi Ishida from a hole at Coordinates (011-024) Sh. 96, Map of Italy 1/100,000 22 August 1946<sup>a</sup> citing upon information supplied by an Italian civilian.

3. Excerpt from report submitted by T/5 Ishida is as follows:

" . . . I proceeded to Arni where we made contact with an Italian civilian who was supposed to know the burial place of an American soldier. We found that not he but his brother knew of the location so we backtracked to C. del Giardino and found the location....

From the Italian we found that the soldier was a POW and was murdered by the Germans. Proceeding to the place we found that the body was thrown into a hole about fifteen feet deep. After recovering the remains we noticed a small brick house near the mouth of the entrance. Asking the civilians around the area we found that the Germans shot the soldier in the small house and that the Italian civilians took the body and shoved it into the hole because the body had begun to smell.

It was further stated that the Germans took all necessary precautions to conceal the identity of the POW. Nothing was found to assist in establishing the soldier's identity. (see incl. A).

The civilians stated that the Germans shot the soldier in the back of the head after finishing questioning him".

Additional information secured by other members of the investigating team:

"It was understood that he was held prisoner in a barbed wire enclosure building prior to being murdered. .... date indicated December 1944.....

Soldier was shot with a pistol in the back of head and neck.  
Skull shows hole."

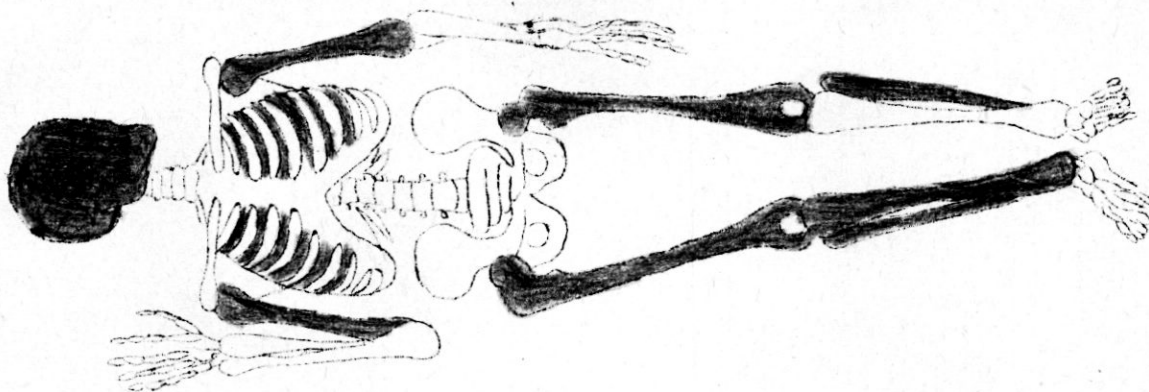

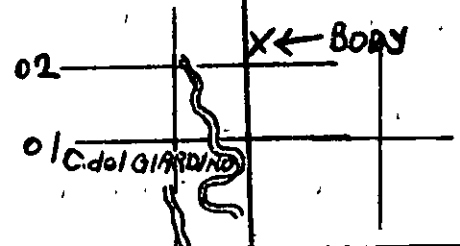
