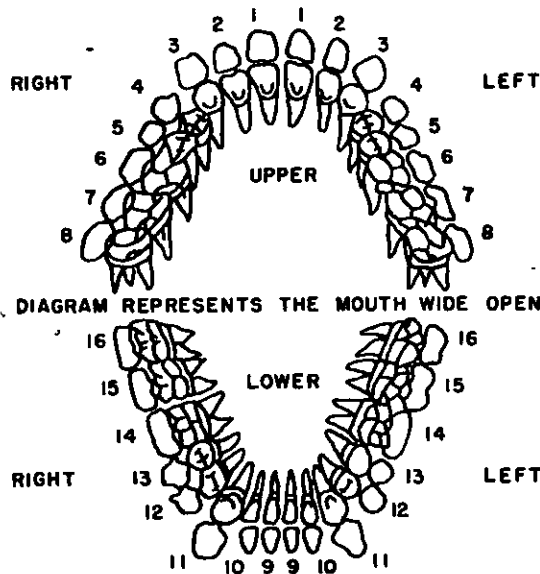


DIAGRAM REPRESENTS THE MOUTH WIDE OPEN

C. Remains were found in area occupied by elements of the 92nd Infantry Division during combat.





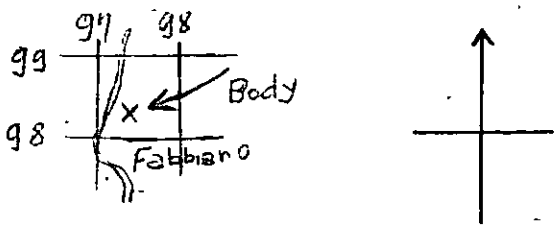
