



We have separated X-163 for the following reasons. X-163 A

had coarse large bones. His estimated height is $5'10\frac{1}{8}$ ".

X-163 B had fine and smaller type bones. His estimated height is $5'7\frac{1}{8}$ ".

We are unable to say whether clothing belongs to X-163 A or X-163 B so are listing them all on X-163 A Checklist.
